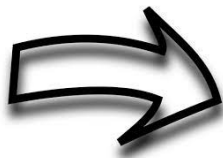

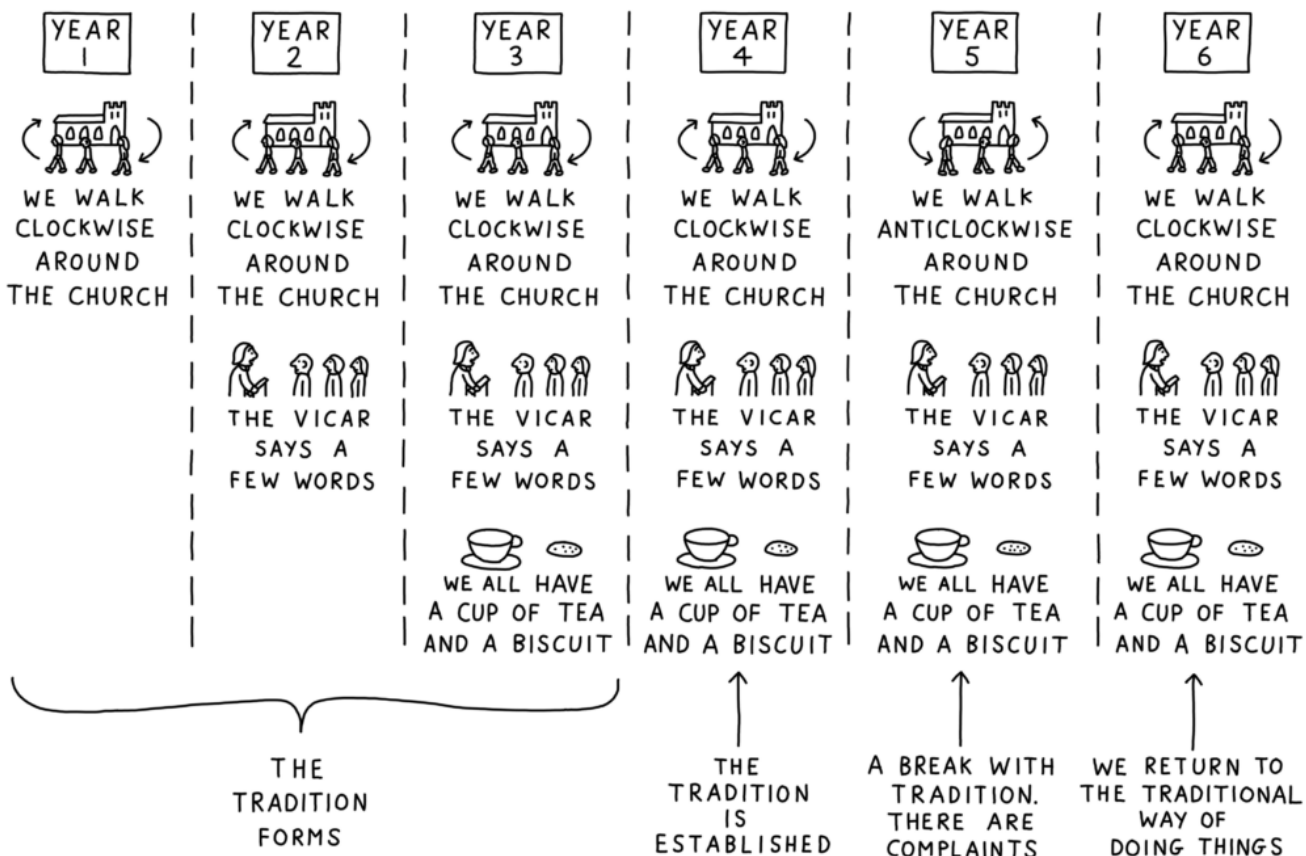


Phenomena | ABC iview
