**FEBRUARY 2022**

We are in the season of Epiphanytide, which lasts until Ash Wednesday on March 2- and then Lent begins. In the context of the Church year, Epiphany refers to the appearance of Jesus Christ as the saviour of the world—of Israel and the Gentiles. For this reason, Epiphany is commonly associated with the visitation of the Magi (or “wise men”), who were almost certainly Gentiles, in Matthew 2:1–12.

I have ordered copies of a Lenten Study Book and will offer groups on Wednesdays following the 9:15 Eucharist and in the evening at 7:30. Lent has been traditionally associated with ‘giving up’: giving up chocolate or alcohol or whatever, in order to spend the time and/or money saved on giving to the church or some other charitable cause. Lent is also a good time to ‘take up’: take up attending a study group, take up reading through part or all of the Bible, take up a regular devotional time of praying and reading.....there are many more possibilities. The aim is to focus our attention more closely on God as we prepare for the events of Holy Week and Easter. Talk to me if you would like some ideas.

At the time of writing we are waiting for guidance from the state government and from Church House regarding future Covid-19 arrangements and restrictions. I will keep you informed as best I can so please check the website and your email inbox for updates, and in the meantime don't forget to wear your mask and check in at church.

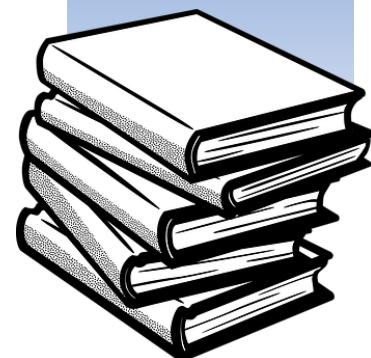
