The Season of Easter lasts for 50 days, until the day of Pentecost: Sunday June 5<sup>th</sup> this year. Pentecost is sometimes called the birthday of the church, because it marks the day when the first disciples of Jesus burst out of their locked hiding place and began sharing the Good News. It is a good day for new beginnings; we have walked the sad journey of Holy Week, celebrated the joy of resurrection, and now we roll up our sleeves to get on with the work of being the Church. Loving our neighbours and gossiping the Gospel- telling people in our actions, our words and the way we live our lives- to continue the work Jesus did during his short time with us.
