It's June, so it must be time for the Annual Meeting of Parishioners! I would like to thank all the people who have sent in reports; special thanks to our Treasurer, Sam, who has the most difficult report of all, encompassing the finances of the past year and a budget for the next. I appreciate all the work that people put in to keeping this parish running.

If you read the emails I've been sending you will know that all the elected positions are now vacant, so nominations are needed for Parish Councillors, Wardens, Lay Members of Synod and an Independent Examiner for the finances. The new parish council appoints from its members a Treasurer and a Secretary.

Parish Annual Meetings are not often well attended; maybe some people think it doesn't concern them, or that it will be boring, or they might be asked to do something they'd rather not do. In fact, this is a really important occasion; and if any parish doesn't have sufficient nominations to form a parish council, that parish is in jeopardy and the Bishop has to come and see if it is viable.

If you have never attended an annual meeting before- make this your first. If you have never put your hand up to serve the parish- why not give it a go? The only requirements are that you are a faithful Anglican Christian who wants to offer some of your time and energy to your church community.

On Sunday June 5th we celebrate Pentecost: the birthday of the Church, when the disciples were filled with the Holy Spirit and began to spread the Good News far and wide. Pentecost is a time to celebrate all the gifts God has given us. We remember the description of 'tongues of flame' appearing and resting on each of them (Acts 2.3) so the liturgical colour is red; if you have something red in your wardrobe wear it to church that day!

17 "In the last days it will be, God declares, that I will pour out my Spirit upon all flesh, and your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, and your young men shall see visions, and your old men shall dream dreams.

18 Even upon my slaves, both men and women, in those days I will pour out my Spirit; and they shall prophesy. (Acts 2)

RECYCLING HUB

Our next Recycling Hub will be **Saturday 18th June at 9-11am**, or especially for parishioners, after each service on Sunday, 19th June. Each Hub collects items that can be **RECLAIMED** instead of heading to landfill. So far, we have **RECLAIMED** over 100kg of plastic bottle tops to be reprocessed in WA and circulated back into the economy by our industry partner, CLAW Environmental. We also partner with the Wanneroo Community Men's Shed who **RECLAIM** parts from and refurbish old computers that are then sold at a reduced price to CentreLink recipients. The people doing the refurbishing and the recipients of the computers are all winners in this circular economy, and the environment wins too! Do you have any old computers you could contribute?
