As you know Allan and I will be leaving the parish at the end of the year; our last Sunday will be on January 1<sup>st</sup> 2023. It was not our 'plan' to leave for another three years, but sadly things change. You may be wondering what happens next. There is a process set out in the Diocesan Clergy Appointments & Licensing Statute 2021\*. The bishop of our region, Bishop Jeremy James, will meet with Parish Council shortly and the nomination process can begin. We elected four Nominators at the annual meeting, and they will work with the Bishop, Archdeacon, and clergy nominators, forming a committee to look for a prospective new Rector. In the meantime (called the 'Interregnum') a half-time locum will be appointed to take the services.

This is a good parish with excellent prospects: there is no debt, buildings are in good shape, and enough income for a full-time priest and 10-hours of administrative assistance (which is worth its weight in gold!) We will advertise far and wide, to have the best possible chance of filling the position as soon as possible.

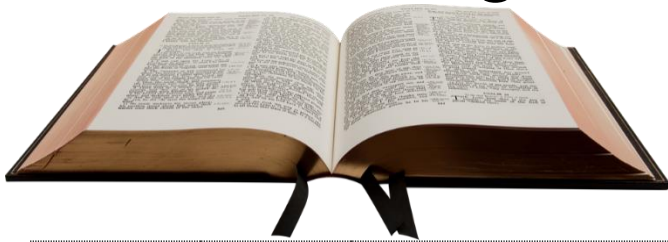

**REPAIR** and coincides beautifully with **International Repair Day** on 15 October. We throw away vast amounts of stuff. Even things with almost nothing wrong, and which could get a new lease on life after a simple repair. The trouble is, lots of people have forgotten that they can repair things themselves. Especially younger generations no longer know how to do that. Knowing how to make repairs is a skill quickly lost. This is a threat to a sustainable future and to the circular economy, in which raw materials can be reused again and again.

The tide is turning however, and as we recognise the need to consume less, repairing is again a skill to be treasured. Repair Cafes are wonderful places where experienced repairers volunteer and fix items for free. The closest Repair Café is in Doubleview and runs on the 2<sup>nd</sup> Saturday of the month from 10am-12pm, at the Guide Hall, 228 Hancock St, Doubleview (just behind the Doubleview House).
