Our next St Nic's Recycling Hub is **Saturday, 19 November, 9-11am**, or especially for parishioners, our mini-Hub will be available after each service on Sunday, 20 November.



Recycling is the last resort after refusing/avoiding buying wasteful items, rethinking our purchases, reducing waste, reusing items instead of throwing them away, and repairing broken items.

Just because the Local Council tells us that they are unable to recycle some items doesn't mean they aren't recyclable. So far this year, the St Nic's Recycling Hub has saved the equivalent of 22 rubbish bins full of plastic lids and plant pots from landfill, as well as approximately 30 garbage bags full of medication blister packs, and countless car boot loads of e-waste, batteries, lightglobes etc taken to the Council Refuse Centre.

www.recycleright.wa.gov.au is a great resource if you are wondering whether something is recyclable, or feel free to check with Marian (0403 026 717).

We are a very small part of the recycling community, and there is so much more that could be done! Keep spreading the word about our Hub so that more of the community can become aware of the alternatives to landfill that are available.

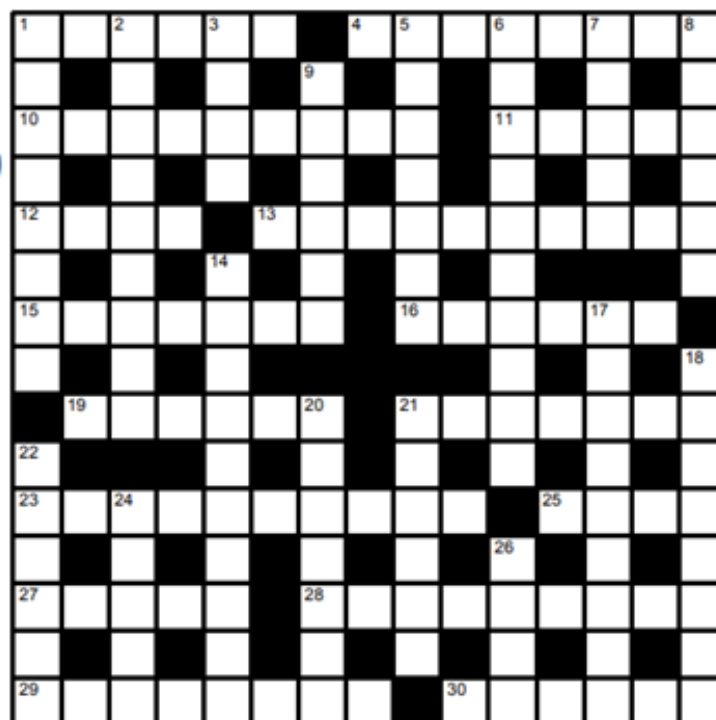
